IPL team, 27% OBC quota: Cong poll promises for MP

New Delhi, 17 October

The Congress manifesto for the Madhya Pradesh Assembly elections released on Tuesday, is abundant with welfare measures for farmers, women, and youngsters. It has also attempted to embrace Hindu cultural traditions, such as renewing the party's commitment to cow protection, promising a "₹100 crore package" for constructing a Narmada pilgrimage corridor and rebuilding old temples.

Madhya Pradesh has 230 Assembly seats, and its 56.13 million electorate will vote on November 17 to elect a fresh House.

Congress state unit president, its chief ministerial face, Kamal Nath, released the 116-page manifesto in Bhopal, where he said his government would work to ensure the state gets its own Indian Premier League team. Senior leaders, including former CM Digvijaya Singh, attended the event, whose highlight was the amicable exchange between him and Nath about the resentment brewing in the party over ticket distribution. Later, in a series of posts on X, Singh defended the ticket distribution process as impartial and promised organisational posts to aspirants whom the party had denied tickets.

According to the manifesto, a Congress government would reconstitute the state's NITI Aayog and Statistical Commission to prepare a five-year plan for the state. The party, if it comes to power, would suggest to the Centre that the

state should have a Legislative Council. It will set up a 'manifesto implementation' sub-committee of the council of ministers to be headed by a vice chairperson under the chief minister's office and district-level committees.

Other highlights of the Congress's "guarantees" are conducting a socio-economic caste Census, increasing other backward class (OBC) reservation from 14 per cent to 27 per cent in the state, a ₹25 lakh health insurance and ₹10 lakh accident insurance for each family, ₹1,500 monthly allowance for women, cooking gas cylinders at ₹500 each, free electricity up to 100 units and 50 per cent waiver in tariff up to 200 units, doubling social welfare pension from ₹600, free school education and ₹1,500 to ₹3,000 allowance for two years to the landless unemployed educated youth.

The party has promised an

urban employment guarantee scheme for unskilled workers, akin to the one in the Congress-ruled Rajasthan, and a minimum income guarantee to youth if the government fails to provide them with work. The manifesto has committed to link farm-related works, such as fencing of agriculture fields, with the existing rural employment guarantee scheme.

A new feature is the focus on landless agriculture workers, or as the manifesto has termed them, "fasal rakshak", or protector of crops, with the promise of the government providing them bicycles, agricultural tools, and their minimum wages out of any compensation to the landholder for crop damage. Besides, the Congress has pledged to continue its earlier scheme of linking farm loans up to ₹2 lakh.

On the jobs front, the party promised to fill 200,000 government vacancies, gradually



inducting contractual workers and banning any long-term outsourcing of services by government departments. It promised loans on easy interest for the self-employed, vehicular loans on low interest and social security net to gig workers and ₹25 lakh at 3 per cent interest for women-led start-ups. On education, to check the dropout rates, students from low-income families enrolled in classes first to eighth will get a ₹500 a month scholarship, those in ninth and tenth ₹1,000 and the ones in higher secondary ₹1,500 a month.

The manifesto juxtaposed the performance of the BJP's 18-year government in the state versus the 15 months that the Nath-led Congress was in power between 2018 and 2020. The manifesto termed those responsible for the party's government "falling" an allusion to Jyotiraditya Scindia, as "traitors".

Cash-for-query row: Plaintiff against Moitra sent to ethics panel

Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla on Tuesday referred BJP Member of Parliament (MP) Manish Sisodia's "bribe-for-query" complaint against Trinamool Congress member Mahua Moitra to the Ethics Committee of the lower House. Dubey accused Moitra of taking "bribes" from a businessman to ask questions in Parliament and urged Birla to constitute an "inquiry committee" to look into the charges against her. Moitra has hit back, saying she "welcomes any move against her after the Lok Sabha Speaker is finished dealing with pending charges against Dubey". The Ethics Committee is chaired by BJP member Vinod Kumar Sonkar.

If bribery not part of offence, it would be tough to prove case against Sisodia: SC to ED

The Supreme Court told the Enforcement Directorate on Tuesday if the bribe that was allegedly paid for tweaking the Delhi excise policy is not part of a predicate offence, then it will be difficult for the federal probe agency to prove the charge of money laundering against

former deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia. A Bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and V R Ravi has reserved its verdict on two separate regular bail pleas of Sisodia in the corruption and money laundering cases.

Sena vs Sena: Last chance for speaker to set time frame

The Supreme Court on Tuesday granted Maharashtra Assembly Speaker Rahul Narwara a final opportunity to give it a realistic time frame for deciding the cross-

petitions filed by the rival factions of the Shiv Sena which he is seeking disqualification of each other's MLAs after a split in the party. A Bench headed by Chief Justice DY Chandrachud noted the submission of Solicitor General Tushar Mehta that he will personally engage with the Speaker during Dussehra vacation and indicate a firm set of modalities.

Semiconductor, deep tech to be in focus at India Mobile Congress

New Delhi, 17 October

The three-day India Mobile Congress (IMC) will showcase the widening convergence of telecom with new domains, such as semiconductors and deep tech. P Ramakrishna, the forum's chief executive officer, said on Tuesday.

With more than 250 global and domestic exhibitors, the seventh edition is expected to draw more than 100,000 visitors this year, he said. There will also be over 5,000 CXO-level delegates and more than 350 speakers.

Deep tech, semiconductors, manufacturing, broadcasting, green energy, innovation centres, and public-sector enterprises will be focal areas, Ramakrishna said. The event, beginning October 27, will also showcase advancements in 5G networks, the increasing use of artificial intelligence (AI) in telecommunications and other domains, edge computing, Industry 4.0, and the emergence of the India stack technologies.

The IMC describes itself as the largest telecom, media, and technology forum in Asia, jointly organised by the Department of Telecommunications and the Cellular Operators Association of India. With the theme of "Global Digital Innovation", the event is expected to play a major role in positioning India as a technology developer, telecom manufacturer and exporter

this year. 6G will be a key theme at the event, given the presence of officials from the International Telecommunications Union (ITU). The United Nations-affiliated ITU recently accepted India's inputs on the 6G technology framework, indicating the country's crucial role in the development of next-generation high-speed technology. In March, India adopted the Bharat 6G Vision document, envisaging the country to be a front-line contributor in the design, development, and deployment of 6G technology by 2030.

At last year's event, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had launched 5G services in India. This year, 14 government departments, such as the Ministry of Heavy Industries and Indian Railways, will showcase industry use cases for 5G that are being deployed, Ramakrishna said. He said around 400 startups were set to participate at the event, along with 100 angel investors. The event will also witness state innovation hubs showcased by 16 states.

"We are also partnering with industry associations across verticals, including manufacturing, the Electronic Industries Association of India, India Electronics and Semiconductor Association, and the Indian Space Association. More than 22 higher educational institutions, including several National Institutes of Technology and Indian Institutes of Technology, will also be part of the event, he said.

Imported food item for re-export doesn't need clearance: FSSAI

The Custom authority does not need to send an imported food item for clearance to the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) if it is meant for re-export or production of value-added items, which are only for exports, the authority has clarified.

The clarification came after several business groups and industry associations approached the regulator in the view of objections raised in some quarters. The advisory should also facilitate ease of doing business.

The FSSAI stated that consignments don't need clearance if they are imported for use in a company's sister concerns or wholly-owned subsidiaries, meant for 100 per cent export production.

However, this is subject to a defined relationship agreement between the two entities and accompanied with a sanitary and health certificate issued by the competent authority of an exporting country.

The food importers may take a self-declaration to the Customs authority, following which the concerned official may issue a 'not in scope' certificate to facilitate the import.

IndiaSkills targets 2.5 mn participants

The Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship on Tuesday launched the IndiaSkills 2023-24 programme and felicitated WorldSkills 2022 winners. India had secured 11th position in the global competition last year.

Addressing the event, Union Minister for Skill Development Dharmendra Pradhan called for increasing the number of participants to 2.5 million from 0.25 million last year, as it would provide impetus to the ecosystem to enhance competency over acquiring degrees.
